ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2022

- With our partners at the Moose Jaw Literacy Network, Moose Jaw Events Centre and Moose Jaw Early Years Family Resource Centre we planned the first annual Touch a Truck show with 1000 visitors!
- 200 people attended our Children and Youth Hallowe'en party.
- The Library became a pilot site for the Provincial Library's Dyslexia Friendly collection
 which includes books published in different fonts and colours to help people with
 dyslexia in making reading accessible.
- Children's Librarian Tina Dolcetti was a contributor to a published article about the diversity of the Moose Jaw Public Library board book collection in "Children and Libraries", a publication of the American Library Association for Library Service to Children.
- Moose Jaw Public Library was the host site for a successful World Breastfeeding Week event. Thanks to the Saskatchewan Health Authority and sponsors for their hard work in supporting young families!
- We introduced a new role of Makerspace Technician and started our maker programming for youth and children. More maker opportunities to come!
- The Library began hosting Rapid Access Counseling delivered by Moose Jaw Family Services for one-time emergency counseling sessions. We are so proud to have them with us!
- We focused on making the Library a safe and positive environment for everyone by undergoing staff training in Trauma Informed Care, The Librarian's Guide to Homelessness and Mental Health First Aid Training.
- We welcomed 122 members of the community for the launch of local poet Robert Currie's new book "Shimmers of Light".
