



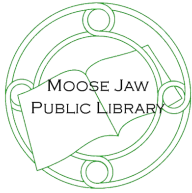

Why should the kids have all the fun?!

Take part in our annual Adult Summer Reading Club and indulge in an adventure that only a good book can take you on. Watch a film, attend a program, or visit the Archives. There is so much you can do at the Library and it is all part of Summer Reading Club!

Once you have your package you can start earning ballots for weekly gift card prize draws and our Grand Prize draw for a night out for two including dinner and entertainment!

How To Participate

1. Pick up your Adult Summer Reading Club *Book-opoly* board from the Library.
2. Start doing the activities on the board or reading the suggested books.
3. Complete a colour set on the board and bring your board to the Information desk. A staff member will initial it for you and give you 1 ballot for the Grand Prize Draw. You have the opportunity to earn 12 ballots (there is no ballot for "free parking"). Ballots can be earned for each of the 8 colour sets, the easy read set, as well as one ballot each for reading slump, GO, and the "go to the Library" spaces.
 - a. Staff will initial a colour set when it is completed and give you a ballot for the grand prize draw. *EXCEPTION: The brown and pink colour sets (programs and services) need to be initialed in each square and a ballot will be given when the set is complete.*
4. Not that ambitious? You can read just one book of your choice or one of the books suggested on the board and fill out a book review slip (make sure you include your star rating). Hand it in at the Information desk and be entered to win a weekly gift card (one review per week permitted however, ballots will remain the draw for all weekly draws with the exception of the winning ballots). Draws will be made every Friday morning. Book review slips are available at the information desk.
5. Weekly winners and reviews will also be featured in our "Get Caught Reading This Summer" social post (optional).
6. Your review will be added to our "Galaxy of Reviews" wall in the Library.
7. There are a total of 11 draws! Ten weekly gift cards and the grand prize draw of a night out for two!

Don't have a Library card? Don't fret! They are free. All you need is a driver's license/Saskatchewan ID or other ID such as a health card and one piece of ID that has your current mailing address (a bill or lease/rental agreement works too).
