**RULES OF CONDUCT FOR LIBRARY USERS**

As a user of the Moose Jaw Public Library I agree to:

- Not engage in disruptive or illegal behaviour including behavior that disturbs staff or other patrons use/enjoyment of the library
- Not engage in threatening, abusive, or harassing language, behaviour or actions toward library staff or other patrons
- Not be under the influence of alcohol or other substances while on Library property
- Not use, buy, sell or distribute drugs, alcohol or substances, illegal or otherwise, while on Library property
- Not carry weapons or implements which can be used as weapons
- Not use cell-phones and other technology in any manner which is loud or distracting to other patrons
- Not take library materials into the public washrooms
- Not steal, cut, tear, break, deface, vandalize or damage library materials or property in any way
- Not view inappropriate or illegal content on public internet stations, or your personal device through the library's wireless network, or on Public Library Property
- Not follow, stalk, harass, or act inappropriately towards staff members or other library patrons
- Wear appropriate attire (such as a shirt, pants, shoes) while in the library
- Promptly leave the library at closing time, during an emergency, or whenever directed by a staff member
- Not loiter or sleep on floors or in doorways, or in any way that would impede traffic-flow throughout the library or other patrons use of the space
- Not bring animals onto Moose Jaw Public Library property, except for registered service animals
- Abide by all Moose Jaw Public Library Policies
